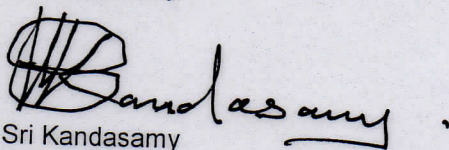

**Promoting sustainable design and education to facilitate Tsunami reconstruction in Sri Lanka**

This is to state that the University of Moratuwa and the University of East London, U.K., have been awarded a partnership link grant funded by the U.K.'s Department for International Development (DfID). This grant, administered by the British Council in Sri Lanka, aims to further the practices of sustainable building design and material use to promote appropriate tsunami re-construction and capacity building in sustainable developmental practice through distance learning. The primary coordinators of the project are: Professor Chitral Wijeyesekera (University of East London) and Professor Rohinton Emmanuel (University of Moratuwa).

Under the above link scheme, Ms. Arosh Gamage of the Dept. of Architecture, University of Moratuwa, will participate in capacity building initiatives.
